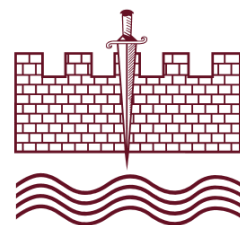

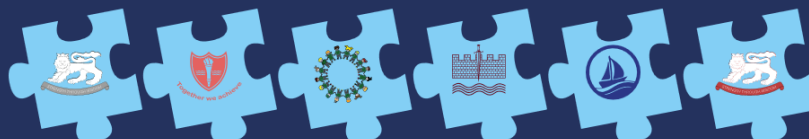
There will be a 7.00pm talk in the Wendy Owen Hall for parents /carers of students from **all other feeder schools**.

**Year 6 New Intake Day**

**Group 1 Arrival 8.20-8.30am**

Students from **Bournes Green, Friars, Great Wakering, Hamstel and Thorpedene** schools are to enter the front entrance of the school (Caulfield Road), wait on the paved area inside the grounds and will be directed to the Wendy Owen Hall.

**Group 2 Arrival 8.50-9.00am**

Students from **all other feeder schools** are to enter the front entrance of the school (Caulfield Road), wait on the paved area inside the grounds and will be directed to the Wendy Owen Hall. (Please do not encourage your child to arrive earlier than 8.50am).

During the morning students will sample a variety of lessons.

Please ensure students:

- Wear their current primary school uniform
- Bring basic equipment including a pen, pencil, ruler and rubber
- Bring refreshments for break including water, as the canteen facilities will not be available to year 6 students during break.
- Sun cream if necessary
- Medication to be brought to reception in the morning if a dose is needed during the New Intake Day

Students will receive their school lunch at approximately 12.00 noon. We are delighted to be able to offer a free school meal for all the year 6 students visiting us on this day. There is also an area where students can eat a packed lunch. **We are a nut free school** and we will need to be notified of any allergies.

Please make arrangements to collect your child from the front of the school on Caulfield Road at **1.20pm** for **Group 1** schools and **1.30pm** for Group 2 schools.

If your child has permission to leave our premises independently, written consent must be provided which will be checked by our senior staff. Please take into account also that this is a busy time of the day and parking is extremely restricted.
