


Partnership Agreement: The Home



As a parent/carer I/we will:

- ensure that our child meets the school's expectations of courteous and responsible behaviour throughout the day, both on school site, to and from school, on local transport and in the community
- ensure that our child abides by the school rules and other regulations set in the school's Behaviour Policy, which can be found on the school website
- Support the school in enforcing the Behaviour Policy
- ensure that our child focuses on learning and supports the school policy regarding mobile phones or devices, accepting that these items will be confiscated if seen or heard
- not use social networking sites to air grievances about the school or make defamatory statements. The school will take action if this does occur
- encourage 100% attendance and punctuality (arrive at 8.20am for an 8.30am start) and confirm the reason for any absence, normally on the first day
- avoid absence, which will affect learning, such as family holidays during term time
- monitor our child's progress and attitude to learning; overseeing homework, reviewing work set on My Child at School each week and encouraging our child to take advantage of help and support available at school when needed
- attend Parents' Evenings or other meetings about our child's progress or education
- ensure that full and correct school uniform is worn each day
- ensure that our child has all the necessary equipment to enable them to do well in all lessons each day
- actively support the work of the staff and governors in school activities and events
- encourage our child to play a full part in the life of the school, including participating in clubs to make maximum use of the opportunities that the school offers
