

## The Course

Any students who do not gain GCSE grade 4 or above in Maths are required by law to resit the qualifications. The course taught and examined in the Sixth Form is the Edexcel course which is also examined in Year 11.

In order to maximise the other options available, GCSE resit classes are taught after school from 15:00 to 16:00. These are compulsory for students who have not achieved a Grade 4 or above; this is considered to be a condition of entry into the Sixth Form.

## Assessment

The assessment routes for the resit GCSE courses are the same as those taken during year 11.

Any student not achieving GCSE grade 4+ must resit GCSE Maths.

Good grades in GCSE Maths are required by virtually all employers. Universities usually require Grade 5 or even Grade 6 for entry
