The Course

During the A-Level Fine Art course you will:

- Develop and extend your artistic skills, whilst experiencing new materials and processes
- Develop your own personal art ideas and style, in the context established artists
- Further develop your ability to evaluate and analyse artworks
- Carry out private study activities including observational studies and research

Assessment

The course is 60% coursework and 40% externally set assignment. Coursework is completed over the first four terms and the ESA in the last two. The ESA takes the form of 15 weeks of preparatory work followed by three days working on a concluding artwork. The coursework component also includes a written element that explores the same themes students develop in their practical work.

Entry Requirements

Pathway 1 or 2 entry requirements plus:

- GCSE Grade 5+ or Vocational Merit+ in an Art and Design Subject
