Script- The written text of a play or film.

Physical theatre- A form of theatre which emphasizes the use of physical movement, as a dance or mime.

Improvisation- creative spontaneously (Without preparation)

Choreography- the art or practice of designing a dance sequence.

Prop- is short for 'property' and is an object used or worn by an actor.



THEATRE ARTS

Prop and set design- creatively look at puppetry and the mechanics of the different size puppets. How to design set and the practicalities needed on stage.

Improvisation- Looking at the language of persuasion. Working effectively in a group. Speaking out loud Infront of an audience.

Jazz dance- Learning and developing choreography, movement memory, alinement, adding energy to a performance. Timing. General performance skills. Creating work within a theme/brief.
