WHAT IS THE 'HEROES' TOPIC?

In this unit we will be looking at a range of unseen texts around the theme of 'heroes'.

Students will explore various kinds of heroes (modern day heroes, war heroes, activists, magical heroes, superheroes, tragic heroes) they might come across and begin to consider what being a hero means to them.
