RE: Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC)

I am sure that you will be aware of the recent news on the issues of RAAC and its impact on schools in the UK.

At Shoeburyness High School, we have identified RAAC following inspection after the DfE policy change and immediately took the rooms out of use prior to the start of term. Classes have been reroomed to minimise impact on curriculum delivery until this is resolved.

We are working very closely with the DfE on interim measures and next steps; as I have any updates on a timeframe, I will keep you informed.

I want to offer my reassurance to you that there is absolutely no risk to students, or indeed anyone at Shoeburyness High School.

No other RAAC is present in the school, and the classrooms identified will remain securely closed off until necessary works have been completed.
