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A-Level Study

Entry requirements:

5 GCSEs at Grade 5+ (including Grade 4+ in English & Maths)

Applicants for A-Level Study should select:

- **Three** A-Levels **or** a combination of A-Levels and applied courses

A small number of students may wish to study four A-Levels (or A-Levels combined with applied courses). This is only suitable for applicants who are expected to achieve grade 6+ on all of their GCSEs





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Supplementary Courses

Core Maths:

- Any student who is studying a Science A-Level (including Psychology) will be expected to continue to study maths in Year 12.
- If they are not studying A-Level Maths, they will be expected to study Core Maths for 1 year.

GCSE resits:

- Any student who has not achieved a minimum of grade 4 in GCSE Maths or GCSE English (Language or Literature) must resit the GCSE course until grade 4 is achieved.
 - This is condition of enrolment in the Sixth Form

GCSE Results & Sixth Form enrolment: 20th August 2026

* late applications are accepted, subject to the availability of places on individual courses

Guaranteed Teaching Hours with expert qualified staff

All courses are taught by expert specialist subject staff and have 5 hours timetabled teaching time each week; there are no reductions in timetabled contact time.

Breadth of Curriculum

Few schools can offer a curriculum with such breadth, with more than 30 courses available including a full range of academic A-Level courses alongside our applied courses.

Dedicated Sixth Form Year Manager

Like the Year Managers lower down the school, Sixth Form Year Manager Mrs Garrod works with me to provide support and guidance to all Sixth Formers to ensure that they are successful.

Wednesday Afternoon Enrichment

For Period 5 on Wednesday, all students can choose from a range of activities to enhance their week and support their wellbeing.

Careers Guidance

In the Sixth Form, Mr Cooper continues to provide fully independent careers advice, alongside a full programme of information on apprenticeships and career skills during Tutor Time.

Friday Afternoon Home Study

All students have the opportunity to leave school early on Friday and complete their studies at home. This is included on the timetable without reducing the number of lessons in each subject.

Record Number of University Applications

A record number of SHS students have progressed to University in 2025. Our mentoring will ensure that all students make good choices and have high aspirations.

Facilities for Private Study

Students have access to excellent facilities for their study periods. Private Study sessions are supervised to ensure a good working environment.




