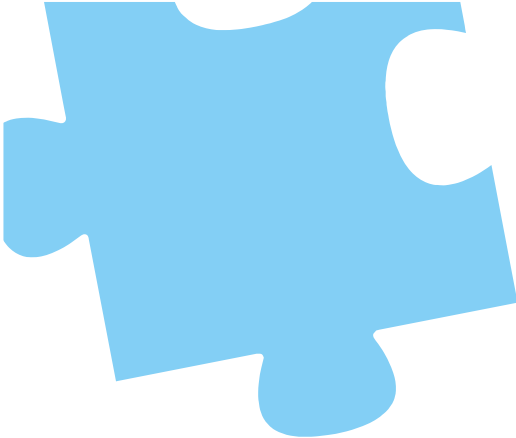
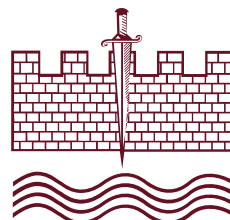

Dear Parents and Carers

Over the past fortnight, we have celebrated the achievements of both our Sixth Form and Year 11 students as they received their examination results. There is, though, another important story within this year's results.

For the third consecutive year, our GCSE outcomes have improved across key measures.
